

DJ Colombia Coffee Growers to Capitalize on Higher Prices -- Market Talk

11:40 EDT - Colombia's coffee crop is set to have a bumper year, says the National Federation of Coffee Growers. The group says national coffee production reached 1.2M bags of 60 kilos in August -- the highest since August 1956, and up 49% since August last year. That's good news for Colombia's coffee growers and their signature brand Juan Valdez, especially as coffee prices reached a four-month high last week. A severe draught in Brazil, followed by early rains, hurt Brazil's crop and could allow Colombia to edge in on Brazil's market.
